VISITATIONS 2024

Firstly, thank you for all you have done for the life of the church during the past year and for taking on this important task. If you are no longer to be Churchwarden, please would you pass this letter to your successor. If no one has been appointed, please let Sarah Hedley in the Diocesan Office (Sarah.Hedley@hereford.anglican.org) know that the position of Churchwarden is now vacant.

I write to invite you to attend the annual Visitation. This year, these are back to being Archdeacon's Visitations, so we are reverting to having five occasions across the Ludlow Archdeaconry. I shall be giving the charge and be swearing in Churchwardens who attend a visitation in the Ludlow Archdeaconry. The Ven Derek Chedzey will give the charge and swear in those attending Visitations in the Hereford Archdeaconry.

Every Churchwarden is required by law to be admitted annually to office by the Bishop or the Archdeacon. Until you have been admitted to office, you are not legally a Churchwarden, and you must be admitted before 31st August 2024. Prior to admittance, you will need to complete a new Declaration form which will be given out at the Visitation and is to be completed and returned before departure.
