About half of these are children, who may have been through horrors hard to imagine. Pray for aid agencies and workers, that people displaced in this way may find compassion and understanding, and for all that helps restore hope and dignity to those forced to leave their home or land. This Week Hildegard of Bingen (remembered on Tuesday) was a prioress and then abbess, an able poet, a composer of music, a mystic and visionary, and wrote on medicine and natural history. Give thanks for those who push the boundaries and challenge norms, and for all who express faith and praise God using poetry and music. Pray for all who live with rheumatoid arthritis, an autoimmune condition in which the immune system impacts on healthy bones, tendons etc in ways that cause severe pain and often deformity. Pray for research into ways to reduce pain and repair damage, and for specialists in this field.
