Ambassador teams volunteer in Hereford to keep people safe, support the vulnerable and provide first aid. Their mission is to make Hereford an even better place to shop, visit and work.

The team forms an essential contact between CCTV operators and shops, in the effort to prevent and report crime, and increase street vigilance.

What do Ambassadors get up to?

Ambassador teams provide a calming presence on our streets to listen and to provide quick support for anyone in need. They are the eyes and ears of our community, available to assist anyone who may be feeling like they need some extra help in their time of need.

Whether a community member is simply having a bad day and needs someone to listen, or a first aid situation develops in which someone needs further support, the Ambassadors are ready to respond in a moment's notice, to whatever circumstance arises.

Ambassador volunteers are offered a bespoke training package, including CCTV, First Aid as well as ongoing sessions with past topics including dementia awareness, Samaritans suicide prevention, working with the police and much more...
