
Support for Ukraine – information for guests



1.Online English lessons for Ukrainians

The organization is offering free online English lessons for Ukrainians who are Beginners (Pre-A1), Elementary (A1), Pre-intermediate (A2) and Intermediate (B1) levels in English. Lessons start at 18:00 UK time (or 20:00 Kyiv time) and are held every day, lasting 40 minutes. You can attend classes every day or just a few days a week. Our teachers are well qualified and experienced and will be happy to help you improve your English.

2. STEP Ukraine is an intensive, virtual, 12-week English language and employment programme for Ukrainians in the UK.

STEP Ukraine is designed to help you find meaningful employment in the UK and improve your English. STEP Ukraine is funded by the UK Government and is completely free for all participants.

It is open to anyone from Ukraine who is over 18 and arrived in the UK on either the Homes for Ukraine Scheme, the Ukraine Family Scheme, or is on the Ukraine Extension Scheme. You can join if you are unemployed or if you have a job but are hoping to move into more relevant employment. We can also support people interested in self-employment.









Support for Ukraine – information for guests

The programme includes:

An intensive 10 weeks of 2.5 hour daily English classes by the British Council, with options to take the lessons morning, afternoon or evening

12 weeks of weekly employment support with a dedicated employment advisor, to support with: CV writing, job applications, interview prep, support with job search, and specialist workshops

All classes are remote, and teacher led. They are streamed so you will be with classmates at a similar level.

4.LUDLOW AREA ADULT LEARNING CENTER

The Ludlow Area Adult Learning Center (LAALC) helps adults learn English and offers other support programs. ABOUT LAALC

LAALC provides free instruction in English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL). Morning and evening classes are offered in levels ranging from true beginner to advanced. In addition, students work with an academic and career advisor and build technology skills. The program provides support for:

- · transition to college;
- · workforce development;
- · family literacy skills;
- · other community goals.

Participants are awarded certificates for attendance, achievement, and completion.
